KHA BEACH RULES

Hours:

- **Parking lot will be closed at 9pm (sharp)** every night. All cars left in the parking lot after 9pm will be locked in for the night!
- Please respect the neighbors; only quiet activities after 10pm per ordinance 135

Entering the Beach Area:

- Beach Tags or State ID (with KHA address) is required to enter. If you do not have a beach tag and cannot prove you are a KHA member or a guest of a KHA member in good standing, entry to the beach area will not be permitted
- Must sign in when entering the beach
- Residents 21 and under can have up to 5 guests at the beach
- Any child 12 years of age or younger needs to be accompanied by an adult or babysitter

While at the Beach:

- There is no lifeguard on duty, swim at your own risk
- No Glass allowed on the beach (this is a safety issue and will result in one day suspension)
- No Smoking or Vaping
- No vandalizing beach property (will result in suspension, length based on severity)
- **No dogs** are allowed inside the fenced in areas including beach/lawn/paved and unpaved parking lots/Marina area with the exception of transferring between car and boat
- No fishing in swim area
- No feeding ducks, geese, swans or any animals on the beach. For further information, please visit the ecology section of KHA's website
- No pushing or throwing sand on the beach (3rd warning will result in a one day suspension)
- Attempting to sink the dock is prohibited (2nd warning will result in a one day suspension)
- No vulgar activity or swearing allowed (will result in one day suspension)
- KHA beach is not responsible for any lost or stolen or damaged materials
- Volleyball and other activities at the beach are first come first serve basis and may not be reserved, however, please be considerate of others waiting to participate
- Kayaks are not allowed inside blue/white buoy line, also must stay away from swimmers in deep swim area

Bonfires: (Updated Rules)

- All bonfires require the person responsible to do the following on the day of the bonfire:
 - Notify the beach staff
 - Home Owner (Adult 21+) must be present at all times during the bonfire.

Beach Reservations:

• Any parties of 20 or more require a reservation. See website for KHA Beach Reservation process

Beach Staff

- Treat them with respect. They are providing a service benefitting all of KHA
- Mistreatment of the staff will result in suspension, length based on severity
